He's also shared the stage with Peter Roewen of New Riders of the Purple Sage, KD Lang, Willie P. Bennett, Penny Lang and Phill Lloyd. Kevin is a well-known face at festivals across Canada and the US along with sharing album credits on many prestigious recordings.

His willingness to lend his talents to concerts for the Yukon Anti-Poverty Coalition, the Yukon Quest, the Christmas telethon and various benefits have earned him a reputation for generosity and kindness.
